we can access it remotely. It's great, so convenient to have access to everything I need, wherever I am, so I don't lose business.”

Carla has also found that SaaS helps her “maintain balance.”

“I can access the information I need and have it be effortless,” she said.

Saying goodbye to old-school processes

Like many photographers, Carla used to have to write everything down before she implemented ShootQ. “It was super, super old school,” she said. “I had spreadsheets and a lot of software.
